On Mission with God

Sometimes it is hard to imagine that God would invite us to join him in his work. If we take an honest look at our lives, we realize our limitations and weaknesses. Usually, that leads us to one basic question. How could God use me? The incredible thing is that it is often in the midst of joining God in his work in our world that we discover and develop new potential in our lives. We grow and learn. Our priorities begin to more closely align with God's purpose. We are "saved by faith." It is not just a one-time experience. It is a lifelong journey with God. Each day we have faith—we believe God. Each day we learn more about God and more about ourselves. Each day we allow God to be at work in our lives. Paul wrote in Romans 8, "We know that all things work together for good for those who love God, who are called according to his purpose. For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son." God is at work in our lives each day to shape our lives into the image of his Son. Even when bad things happen God is still working. Everyday God is at work making us more like Jesus. Most of us know he still has a lot of work to do in our lives. This "reshaping" of our lives is designed for "his purpose." He is making us into the instruments of his grace that he created and desires us to be. He prepares us for his work in our world. He helps us fulfill our "real purpose." What kind of place would First Christian Church become if we all decided to join God in his work? I believe it would be an exciting, creative, and powerful place where people could meet God. It would be a place where lives were changed every day. It would be a place where people realized their potential and found great joy. It would be the kind of place all of us want to be. One of my favorite Bible stories when I was a child was the story of Zacchaeus—the short tax collector who climbed a tree to see Jesus. When Jesus announced salvation had come to the house of Zacchaeus, he was not just saying something about Zacchaeus. He was saying something about his mission. Luke records his words in Luke 19:10, "For the Son of Man came to seek out and to save the lost." God has been 'on mission' since the beginning. He has been about the task of redeeming his creation. Jesus said to his followers in John 20:21, "As the Father has sent me, so I send you." Missions is not merely something the church does. It is not just one of our programs. Missions is who are. It is why we exist. We are the "sent ones." We have joined God. We have become co-laborers with God (1 Corinthians 3:9). Everywhere we go we are on mission. Everywhere we go we are sharing the story of Jesus. We have adopted his way of living—the Jesus way. We have done this because we have come to know that his way is the way of life. Missions begins right where we are and extends as far as we can reach through our praying, our giving, and our going. What a privilege to be on mission with God.
