A Future With Hope

This Sunday we will begin our annual Stewardship Emphasis. Our theme this year is a Future with Hope. As we think about our personal stewardship, we are going to be explore passages of scripture that focus upon periods of "exile" and opportunities to "return." Most of us feel like we have been in exile as we have tried to cope with the pandemic for more than a year and a half. It has been tough to not be able to do everything we want to do. Even though we are still having to take precautions to protect our congregation and community, I am glad many of our members have been able to resume in-person worship. Obviously, some are continuing to worship online because of health concerns or a compromised immune system.

The truth is that life has always been a rhythm of separation and togetherness, exile and return. We may prefer the "return" bit, the "bring you back to this place" bit, but that doesn't mean separation isn't part of the story. Over the next three weeks during our Stewardship Emphasis, we will examine three stories from scripture where people had to deal with exile. This week we will Joseph's forced exile in Egypt when his brothers sold him into slavery. I hope you will plan to join us each Sunday for this special series.

We will only have one worship service on Sunday, September 19, and we will be meeting at the North Jefferson Park for worship at 10:00 a.m. In addition to beginning our Stewardship Emphasis, we will also have a special presentation and discussion led by our Strategic Planning Committee. Lunch will be provided immediately following the worship service, and following the lunch, the committee will share a brief report on the progress of their work. The committee members will lead small group discussions to provide an opportunity for our members to provide feedback on the committee's work on a list of proposed "core values" and the "mission" and "vision" statements. It will not be a long session, and I hope you will make a special effort to be present. There will be picnic tables, but plan to bring your lawn chair if you have one.

This special session with the Strategic Planning Committee fits perfectly with the beginning of our Stewardship Emphasis and our theme: A Future with Hope. Sometimes circumstances are beyond our control. The pandemic has certainly reminded us of that reality. Joseph never expected to find himself in Egypt, but he discovered that even during the times of separation and hardship God is always present. He never forsakes us. He is always faithful. I hope to see you Sunday at the park.

REMINDER: As you know Missouri, and specifically our community, continues to see many COVID cases. I want to thank you for being responsive to the Worship Committee's recommendation: First Christian Church strongly recommends that everyone worshiping with us wear a mask to protect yourselves and more importantly out of respect for others. As you know, this is the current recommendation of the CDC and other medical experts for both vaccinated and unvaccinated people when indoors in high infection areas, like Cole County.
